There are two possible modes of colocation.

Colocation: Beginning Service enabling telecommunications companies to set up equipment on Míla's premises.

Nearby colocation: Circumstances where a telecommunications company sets up its equipment on premises near a telephone exchange.

Description

In connection with access to an access cable, Míla offers telecommunications companies the option of setting up equipment with colocation in Míla telephone exchanges so long as space in a nearby building is available. Where there is not sufficient space, and a telecommunications company has to procure premises nearby, this is not Míla's concern except with regard to facilities for connection (copper cables between a telecommunications company's premises and Míla's distribution frame).

What are the conditions for getting service?

The customer must have general authorization for telecommunication operations and telecommunication services from the Post- and Telecom Administration and also provide third-party service.
