Trunk lines are digital lines between telephone exchanges.

Description

Trunk lines are used for voice and data transport. It is also necessary to lease a user line if the lessee's net connection point lies outside a telephone exchange. Trunk lines can be leased with a transport capacity ranging from 64 Mb/s to 622 Mb/s.

The lease price of a trunk line is divided in two:

A fixed monthly charge is invoiced for each line and, in addition, a charge for the length of the line. It is also necessary to lease a user line if the lessee's net connection point lies outside a telephone exchange.

If a party leases more than 1800 km of lines with transport capacities of 45-622 Mb/s, he will receive a 25% discount on the fixed lease price although not on the lines of transport capacity under 2 Mb/s.

The initialization fee for the installation and connection of lease lines outside the fibre-optic cable circuit, which can be costly, is decided on a case-by-case basis.

Iceland Telecom also offers these connections as backup routes.
